<b>Perseverance</b>  <i>I will not give up</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Tutorials for joining Google Classrooms and submitting work are available for both students and parents on the CPS home page</li> <li>● Expect to make minor mistakes, remote learning is new for all</li> <li>● When faced with a challenge, use good strategies-(take a break, reread directions, ask for tech support,email your teacher, breakdown your work, tackle one assignment at a time etc..)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Ask a teacher, parent or sibling for assistance if the meeting code/password is not working</li> <li>● Try using another device with the same meeting code/password</li> <li>● Dial into the meeting with your phone by using the 11 digit dial-in # in the meeting invite</li> </ul>
<b>Respect</b>  <i>I treat everyone &amp; everything with care</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Google Classrooms are extensions of our McCarthy classrooms, students will uphold the same code of conduct and PRIDE expectations</li> <li>● Use your time on your/your family’s device for the learning activities assigned by your teachers; set specific time aside (outside of your learning day) for checking social media news feeds, posts and trends</li> <li>● Take proper care of your device</li> <li>● Limit food or drink near the device when working</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Google Meet is an extension of our McCarthy classrooms, students will use appropriate school language free from swearing, teasing and insults</li> <li>● Refrain from speaking over classmates</li> <li>● Mute your microphone when asked by your teacher or when you are not speaking</li> </ul>
<b>Integrity</b>  <i>I do what is right</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Remote learning work is required by all students; it is not optional</li> <li>● Receive credit for completing assignments; missed assignments result in no credit</li> <li>● Posts and comments should directly relate to the classroom topic or discussion; use your social media accounts to discuss tv shows, gaming, pets, your playlists etc..</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Use the Google Meet time with your teachers and classmates wisely</li> <li>● Be prepared with specific questions and stay on topic during discussions</li> <li>● Use skills for learning (eyes watching, ears listening, voice quiet)</li> <li>● Attend your Google Meet as you would attend school: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ be appropriately dressed; robes and blankets are for non-meeting times</li> <li>○ Bring only necessary materials; refrain from bringing disruptive things such as pets and toys.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Dedication</b>  <i>I am committed to my school</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Be present in the virtual world</li> <li>● Check in M-F for your teachers’ assignments and feedback</li> <li>● Complete your work for credit</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Keep your charger close, Google Meet drains battery power when in use</li> <li>● Make sure your device is plugged in at the end of your learning day.</li> </ul>
